Chili Cook-Off Rules

- 1. Traditional and Other Chili must be cooked on site. You may cut up meat and vegetables and pre-mix spices at home. (no pre-cooking) Teams are to cook a minimum of 2 gallons of chili. (This will ensure enough for chili tastings) No open flames. Must use propane only.
- 2. Home Cooks bring chili (1 gallons) ready to serve by 10:45 a.m.
- **3.** Must bring your own shade, chairs, ingredients, and cooking gear including stoves and tables. (Don't forget sunscreen.)
- **4.** This is a Family Event. Any adult beverages must be handled discretely and responsibly.
- **5.** Chili will be judged on: Aroma, Color, Consistency, Taste, and Aftertaste.

 Judges will not be allowed into the cooking area before judging is complete. Judging will be conducted under a double blind presentation all in the same type of container to ensure no biased voting.
- 6. Winners will be in these categories:

Traditional Texas (no beans or extras); Chili Judges Choice 1st –3rd

Other 'Sort of Like' Chili (Beans, Chicken, Tofu, etc.); Judges Choice 1st—3rd

Home Cooks; Judges Choice 1st—3rd
